

Museum Field Science Program Safety Guide Lines

The following guidelines will be enforced to ensure the safety of all participants. In addition, the trip leader may have other rules to add to the list depending on the field trip and circumstances. We want you to have fun, but we also want you to be safe, avoid injury and learn a lot!

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE MUSEUM STAFF HAS THE RIGHT AND RESPONSIBILITY TO TERMINATE A FIELD TRIP IF PARTICIPANTS FAIL TO BEHAVE PROPERLY.

1. During canoeing field trips, ALL participants (regardless of their swimming ability) must wear a life jacket (personal floatation device) provided by the museum.
2. Shoes must be worn at all times. No sandals, aqua socks or open-toed shoes.
3. No iPods, radios or other electronic devices **except** cameras.
4. No swimming or diving in the water and no rope swings.
5. No horseplay.
6. No drugs, alcoholic beverages or controlled substances.
7. No smoking or use of tobacco products.
8. No pets.
